Their needs include:

Empowerment

Colonialism, politics, education and aid have created a culture of dependency amongst Zimbabwe's poorest people. Above all, Zimbabweans need the tools to build their own future: self-respect and responsibility, skills and ideas.

Education

Many Zimbabweans can't afford to send their children to school. Schools don't have enough teachers or books.

Livelihoods

Jobs, investment and business skills are in short supply, and there's no welfare system in Zimbabwe.

Health

Most Zimbabweans can't afford medical care, nor can they travel the many miles to the nearest clinic, where staff, equipment and supplies are short.

Agriculture

Access to water, changing weather patterns and limited expertise are common barriers to crop quality and quantity.

Sanitation and water

Urban piped water is more often 'off' than 'on'. Rural wells are seasonal and far off. Both are often unsafe. Urban sewers have not coped with population growth. Rural hygiene understanding is very limited. Deaths from preventable diseases are all too common.



SEED is helping to meet these needs, in a way that lasts

Empowerment

SEED doesn't do hand-outs. For example, instead of paying 100 children's school fees for a term, we help their parents develop business skills so they can pay school fees themselves, for years to come.

Quality over quantity. Dignity over dependence. Lasting change.

Success is a community that doesn't need us any more.

Education

SEED helped Rusike village to set up a pre-school. They then helped three more villages to do the same.

Livelihoods

By training groups of Harare's uneducated adults in practical and business skills (e.g. carpentry, catering), we empowered them to earn a living.

Health

We offered peer health education to 73,000 families across Harare's poorest areas, using local volunteers.

Agriculture

SEED demonstrated new agricultural methods in rural Murehwa, leading to improved community nutrition.

Sanitation and water

We taught Mwanza village how to dig a well, and showed Rusike village how to build drop-toilets, using local free resources (sand and labour) where possible.
